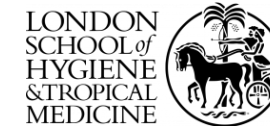

- Crisis resilience

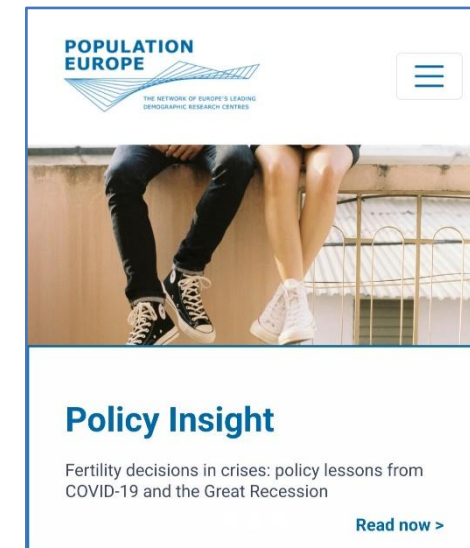
European policy dialogue on demography

- Since 2009, the secretariat has led or organised work packages for 10 **EU-funded projects**, including We-ID, FutuRes, MapIneq, QuantMig, VULNER, GGP-EPI and FamiliesAndSocieties
- Since 2019, Population Europe has contributed to regular **stakeholder meetings** with the European Commission, European Parliament, European Economic and Social Committee, and other EU institutions
- **Event series**, such as the Berlin Demography Days (in cooperation with EAPS, IUSSP, national associations) and the European Day of Demography (February 4th)
- **Meetings with other institutions** (e.g. OECD, UNFPA, national, regional and local governments)

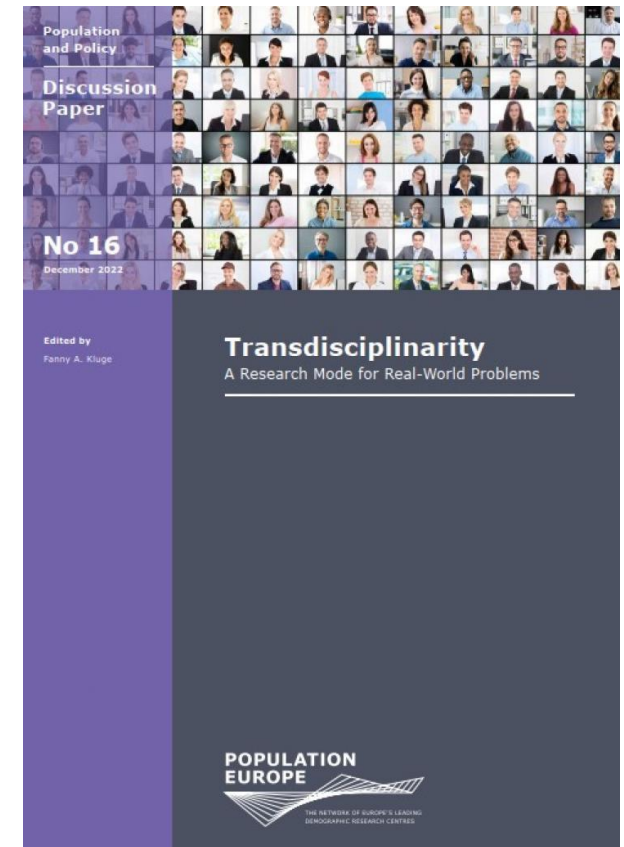
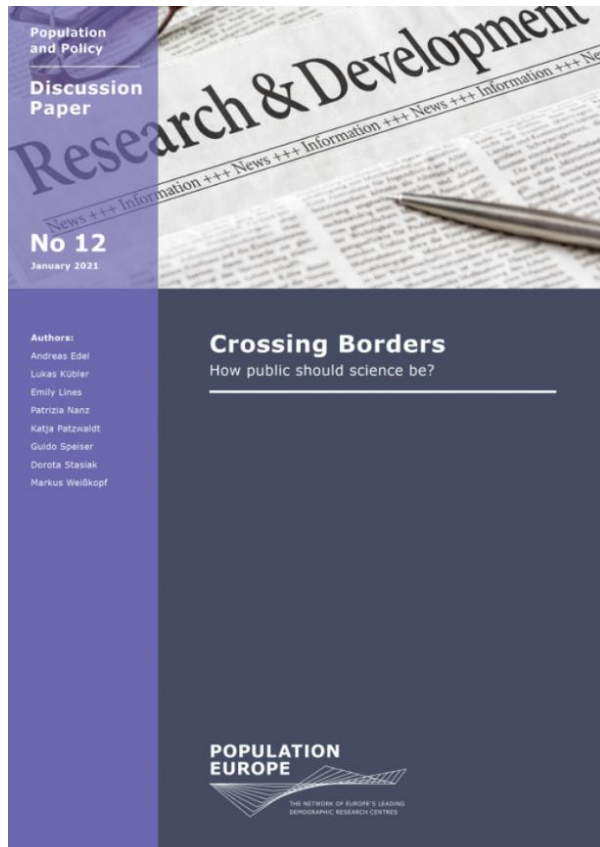


Population Europe Policy Lab

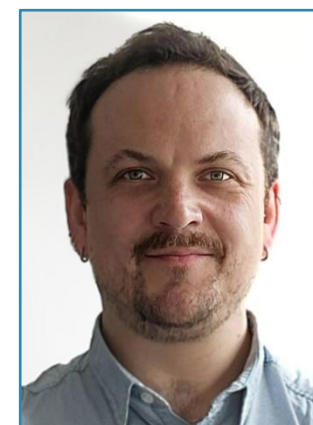
