European policy dialogue on demography

- Since 2009, the secretariat has led or organised work packages for 10 EU-funded projects, including We-ID, FutuRes, MapIneq, QuantMig, VULNER, GGP-EPI and FamiliesAndSocieties
- Since 2019, Population Europe has contributed to regular stakeholder meetings with the European Commission, European Parliament, European Economic and Social Comittee, and other EU institutions
- Event series, such as the Berlin Demography Days (in cooperaiton with EAPS, IUSSP, national associations) and the European Day of Demography (February 4th)
- Meetings with other institutions (e.g. OECD, UNFPA, national, regional and local governments)

- Targeted publications (Insights Digests Social Media)






